## 2011:

- Included, apart from countless small feelings of success with individual orphans, a real highlight with the dedication and commissioning of the new Orphan Care Centre Lesedi-Potlana. Everybody, orphans, care givers, school body, donors and the responsible people operating the centre are exited. The kids (around 80) feel very happy and comfortable and blossom out in the secure environment and loving care at the centre.
- Our partners A2C formed a legal entity "Go Amagelo" (English: To embrace) as a super ordinate management organisation for all the Orphan Care Centres. With this, the comprehensive work in Soshanguve has been brought to a next level of professionalism. A board consisting of all relevant parties guarantees the fulfilment of the entire regulatory framework required by the government in connection with the care taking of orphans.
- The feedback given by almost 30 people from various countries showed and confirmed that the „House of Encouragement“ suits a social need and fully complies with the intended purpose. After the time at „The Hills“ all guests went back to their challenging responsibilities in favour of the needy courageously and with a new vision.
- Brought a clear distinction between the two purposes of the foundation "Orphan Care Centres" and "House of Encouragement" (see homepage). As of January 2012, the sole purpose of the foundation is to support and care for orphans in South African townships. The second activity - the house of encouragement in Pretoria - has been deleted from the articles of association and is continued only on a private basis. Thus all donations to the foundation will be used exclusively for the work with and for the orphans.

## Review

After the commissioning of the centre Lesedi-Potlana everyday responsibilities were assigned to the volunteers in all the centres. Under the supervision of Willem Basson, the daily operational tasks are now taken over by a team of two in each centre. While the one person focuses primarily on the administrative and technical management of the centre, the second person pays attention to the care of the orphans and their individual needs. Several volunteers help the team leaders in the versatile work with great commitment. In order to support the new team leaders in their gaining experience Willem Basson daily spends several hours at the centres. In addition the team leaders attend a comprehensive training during several months and also the other volunteers complete the seminar "It Take Courage" (given by our American partners), a most valuable training for their work with the children. The necessary and sustaining involvement of local people has been enhanced significantly in our work during 2011. The team consists of 17 local volunteers in the three centres.

After the official inauguration of the new centre Lesedi-Potlana in May, we decided to conduct a small ceremony with the children and their foster mothers later in the year. It was important for all of us, that this event was for the children and that they should take centre stage in this event. So the few short speeches were directed exclusively to the orphans and the afternoon programme well adapted for the kids.

An initiative of our partner organisation Acts2Change last July aimed to obtain official recognition of our Orphan Care Centres by the Department of Social Work. This department presented some requests which A2C had to fulfil regarding the management and the facilities of the centre. A reporting system and inspection process was defined. For each centre, a steering committee comprising representatives from the local population will be formed. As a consequence it made sense to start the new organisation Go Amagelo. At the end of the year the recognition of the Centre Pulamadibogo was confirmed. After the official registration of Go Amagelo we can now apply for a financial contribution towards the compensation of the volunteers (not for the operation of the centre or the care and support of the orphans). If such cost sharing is approved, we are happy to pay the very talented and dedicated volunteers a slightly higher compensation after more than three years of outstanding work. Ultimately, this will be important for the continuity of care taking work at the centres.

The worldwide economic situation has had an impact on our budget respectively the rendered services this year. Several planned activities and support measures could not take place for financial reasons. Yes, we were faced with great challenges as for example to ensure the daily meals for the kids. However, the orphans know nothing of economic crisis or recession. They are simply hungry, vulnerably and in need of our care and support. Literally, for many of them - without the support at the day care centre - the struggle for daily food is a hard reality. We therefore would like to call on you to consider a "child sponsorship" to secure the sustainable work for and with the children. Many thanks!
